

Diesel Fuel Surcharge

Payments set forth in the base rates shall be adjusted according to fluctuations in the “National Average” beginning on October 1, 2004. This average is defined as the three-week rolling average of the diesel fuel National weekly price (self-service, cash, including taxes) as calculated by the Dept of Energy and published by the Energy Information Administration.

For diesel fuel prices greater than \$2.092 the surcharge rate shall increase incrementally by .01 cents for each .06 cents increase in fuel cost. Fuel Surcharge is based on the weekly published Department of Energy (D.O.E), National Average for diesel fuel Cost per mile (CPM) will apply using Mile Finder PCP unless a minimum is charged then percentage will apply.
